Airports

Buses from Logan airport: Peter Pan/Bonanza (<http://www.peterpanbus.com/>)

To get to Falmouth or Woods Hole from Boston, take the Peter Pan Bus from Logan Airport and downtown Boston to the Bus Depot in Falmouth on Depot Avenue.

Driving directions from Boston, Massachusetts

Head southeast and take a slight right toward Harborside Drive. Follow on for signs to I-90W. Turn right toward Harborside Drive. Turn left at Harborside Drive. Turn left onto the ramp to I-93/Williams Tunnel/I-90W. Merge onto I-90W/Mass Pike/Ted Williams Tunnel. Take exit 25-24 to merge onto I-93S/US-1S. Follow I-93S to Route 3 south.

Stay on Route 3 south; follow signs for Cape Cod. Cross the Sagamore Bridge, take the first exit off Route 6, and follow signs for Falmouth and Route 28. Travel south along the Cape Cod Canal until you reach the rotary at the base of the Bourne Bridge. Three quarters of the way around the rotary, bear right and continue south on Route 28.

At the second rotary on Route 28, travel halfway around, bearing right to continue south to the town of Falmouth. Bear right at the Gulf station onto Woods Hole Road. Travel two and one-half (2.5) miles to WHOI's Quissett campus (on the left), or four (4) miles to WHOI's facilities in the village of Woods Hole. Please note that parking is extremely limited in the village, especially in summer.

Driving directions from Providence, Rhode Island

Head east on Airport Connector Road E. Slight left toward Airport Connector Road W. Slight right toward Airport Connector Road W (signs for I-95). Continue straight onto Airport Connector Road W. Merge onto I-95 N via the ramp to Providence. Take exit 20 to merge onto I-195 E/US-6 E toward East Providence/Cape Cod. Continue to follow I-195 E entering Massachusetts. Take exit 22A to merge onto Route 25E toward Cape Cod. Continue on Route 28. Follow signs for Cape Cod. Cross the Bourne Bridge, travel halfway around the rotary on the Cape side of the bridge, and follow signs to Route 28, Falmouth, and Woods Hole. Continue south on Route 28, as directed below.

At the second rotary on Route 28, travel halfway around, bearing right to continue south to the town of Falmouth. Bear right at the Gulf station onto Woods Hole Road. Travel two and one-half (2.5) miles to WHOI's Quissett campus (on the left), or four (4) miles to WHOI's facilities in the village of Woods Hole. Please note that parking is extremely limited in the village, especially in summer.










Arctic Ocean Model Intercomparison Project


New England Maps






Falmouth, Massachusetts Map

Directions from Boston Logan Airport – Distance 70mil.

Route I-93 S to Route 3 S. Travel over the Sagamore Bridge. Take first exit (exit 1). At the end of the exit, turn left at light. Proceed to rotary to Route 28 S (3rd exit on rotary). Follow 13 miles to first traffic light. Continue straight through the traffic light. (Once in Falmouth, Route 28 is also known as North Main Street). In Falmouth, you will pass the Steamship Authority parking lot on the right. From there, the Inn on the Square is located three blocks down on the right at 40 North Main Street.

Route I-93 S to Route 3 S. Travel over the Sagamore Bridge. Take first exit (exit 1). At the end of the exit, turn left at light. Proceed to rotary to Route 28 S (3rd exit on rotary). Follow 13 miles to first traffic light and turn left on Jones Road. Hotel is one half mile on right.
